

Srpf Script & expectations.

1. Sign up and commit to the Nov. 11-12 Event.
2. Take materials for spreading the word. Figure out what we are trying to do.
 - a. Raise support for SBP (actual building materials)
 - b. Raise awareness for the need after this Hurricane Season—encourage support
 - c. Raise funds for our service work.
3. Read over stuff. Make a list with your parents and peers of who would be supportive of this. Think “My Neighbors might be interested in donating cans & bottles.” “My grandmother might light to come and have soup at the event and see what youth group does.” “My mom’s friend owns a restaurant and might be willing to let me pick up their cans & bottles for us to redeem.” “I go to Dr. Soandsos and they might be willing to sponsor a building material.” “My brothers baseball team like pancakes; maybe they would come to the pancake breakfast.” Be Creative.
4. Send out materials. Post the flyer on social media or share it! Tell your friends what you are doing & invite them to come and eat or hear speakers or donate to the Luminaries of support. Get the word out.
5. See script below.
6. For neighbors and family, you might not need to be so formal. They will be excited to hear what you are doing.

Going to a business/organization for support.

1. Know what you are talking about. (above 2 a, b & c)
2. Take a parent/adult and a buddy or 2.

We are passionate about helping hurricane victims. We have worked for many years helping people get back into their homes after disasters. I would like to tell you about our Home is Where the Heart is: Hurricane Relief Project for Nov. 11-12.

Our mission to help victims. This is what we are going to do: sponsor building & clean up supplies, raise awareness and support, and go and help.

We are sponsoring building materials for cleaning up and rebuilding homes through the St Bernard Project, who shrink the time between disaster and recovery. Our group has worked with St Bernard Project since 2008. SBP is already cleaning up flooded and damaged homes in Texas after Hurricane Harvey. They need clean up

materials and building supply sponsors. You can see the list of possible items on this sheet.

Just think—you could actually sponsor a sink for a home, or new flooring! Simple...but this means so much to a family who has lost everything and who doesn't have the means or insurance to replace it!

Your donation is tax deductible, too!

On Nov. 11-12, we are going to have speakers and our youth group talk about the need, the experience of having to seek shelter, and what support means.

You can show your support by adding to our Luminaries of Support experience. For \$5 you can honor someone who has been impacted by one of the recent hurricanes: Harvey, Irma or Maria, or an experience further back...like Hurricane Sandy. These luminary bags with your message will light the night on Nov. 11-12 and show our community's support for those far away who face such massive struggle.

Finally, we invite you to come and learn that night. Hear our speakers, talk with us and enjoy a soup supper. And come back on Sunday morning for a pancake breakfast.

And you can donate your cans & bottles that afternoon as well!

I am happy to help you choose a material to sponsor, or clean up materials. And I would welcome your message for a luminary bag or to reserve spots for soup or pancakes! And I am happy to answer any questions.
