### **Common Questions**



What is our goal for ministry programs? This year to support our ministries and accomplish our intentions for relevant outreach and faithful practices of love, we need \$295,000 in pledges for our 2024 budget.

#### How much should I give?

Giving/pledging is a faith practice that emerges from your relationship with God. The Bible describes a tradition of tithing, which is 10% of your income. We hope that you will consider giving a range of 4-8%. Some givers count their offerings to First Church, along with their other charitable giving, to calculate this amount. Every gift is important and will help us carry out our open and affirming mission to love others.

## Are there other ways I can give?

The pledge commitment card allows you to decide your frequency of giving-weekly or monthly. Recurring payments through your banking system or our website are options. From your total commitment pledge, you will divide by the frequency to determine the amount.


## Discerning How Much to Give
