Attitude - Psalm 127:3-4

Discouraged - Psalm 42:5

Why are you cast down, O my soul,  
and why are you disquieted within me?  
Hope in God; for I shall again praise him, my help

Exasperation - Ephesians 4:29

Let no evil talk come out of your mouths, but only what is useful for building up, as there is need, so that your words may give grace to those who hear.

Exasperation - Psalm 32:8

I will instruct you and teach you the way you should go;

I will counsel you with my eye upon you.

Fear - Psalm 91:4

...he will cover you with his pinions,  
and under his wings you will find refuge;

his faithfulness is a shield and buckler.

Harmony - Colossians 3:13-14

Bear with one another and, if anyone has a complaint against another, forgive each other; just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive. Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony.

Hope - Psalm 119:114

Exasperation - Ephesians 4:1-2

Growth - Psalm 139:23-24

Search me, O God, and know my heart;

test me and know my thoughts.

Healing - Proverbs 12:18

Rash words are like sword thrusts,  
but the tongue of the wise brings healing.

Hope - Romans 15:13'

Hurt - Psalm 34:18

Memory - Isaiah 49:14-15

Peace - Numbers 6:24-26

Justice - Isaiah 1:16-17

remove the evil of your doings  
from before my eyes;  
cease to do evil, learn to do good;  
seek justice, rescue the oppressed,  
defend the orphan, plead for the widow.

Love - 1 Peter 4:8

Above all, maintain constant love for one another, for love covers a multitude of sins.

Mercy, Love, Justice - Micah 6:8

He has told you, O mortal, what is good;  
and what does the Lord require of you  
but to do justice, and to love kindness,  
and to walk humbly with your God?

Peace - Philippians 4:6

Do not worry about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.

Perseverance - Psalm 16:8

I keep the Lord always before me;

Rest - Exodus 34:21

Safety - Psalm 91:1-2

Strength - 2 Corinthians 12:10

Strength - Philippians 4:13

Pray - Psalm 86:6-7

Rest - Matthew 11:28-30

"Come to me, all you that are weary and are  
carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you  
rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn  
from me; for I am gentle and humble in  
heart, and you will find rest for your souls.  
For my yoke is easy, and my burden is  
light."

Spirit - 2 Timothy 1:7

for God did not give us a spirit of

Strength - Psalm 73:26

My flesh and my heart may fail,  
but God is the strength of my heart  
and my portion forever.

Teaching - Deuteronomy 4:9

But take care and watch yourselves

Thankfulness - 1 Samuel 1:27

For this child I prayed; and the Lord has granted me the petition that I made to him.

Tiredness - Psalm 4:8

I will both lie down and sleep in peace;  
for you alone, O Lord, make me lie down in safety.

Trust - Proverbs 3:5-6

Trust in the Lord with all your heart,  
and do not rely on your own insight.  
In all your ways acknowledge him,  
and he will make straight your paths.

Wisdom - Proverbs 4:6-7

Do not forsake her, and she will keep you;  
love her, and she will guard you.  
The beginning of wisdom is this: Get wisdom,  
and whatever else you get, get insight.

Work of the Spirit - Galatians 5:22-23
